The First Noel, The Angel Did Say

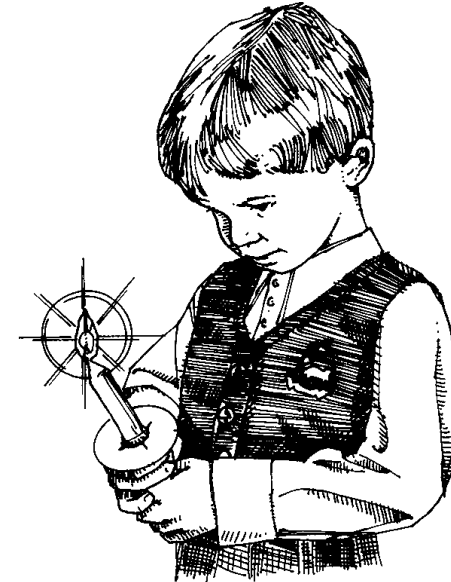
The first Noel, the angel did say,
