disciples saw the Lord, they were filled with joy.

All: "Peace be with you."

Leader: Jesus breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive anyone's sins, they are forgiven; if you don't

Scripture Acts 2.1-8, 12-21

1 When Pentecost Day arrived, they were all together in one place. 2 Suddenly a sound from heaven like the howling of a fierce wind filled the entire house where they were sitting. 3 They saw what seemed to be individual flames of fire alighting on each →

one of them. 4 They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages as the Spirit enabled them to speak.

5 There were pious Jews from every nation under heaven living in Jerusalem. 6 When they heard this sound, a crowd gathered. They were mystified because everyone heard them speaking in their native languages. 7 They were surprised and amazed, saying, "Look, aren't all the people who are speaking Galileans, every one of them? 8 How then can each of us hear them speaking in our native language? 12 They were all surprised and bewildered. Some asked each other, "What does this mean?" 13 Others jeered at them, saying, "They're full of new wine!"

14 Peter stood with the other eleven apostles. He raised his voice and declared, "Judeans and everyone living in Jerusalem! Know this! Listen carefully to my words! 15 These people aren't drunk, as you suspect; after all, it's only nine o'clock in the morning! 16 Rather, this is what was spoken through the prophet Joel:

- 18 Even upon my servants, men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy.
- 19 I will cause wonders to occur in the heavens above and signs on the earth below,
 blood and fire and a cloud of smoke.
- 20 The sun will be changed into darkness, and the moon will be changed into blood, before the great and spectacular day of the Lord comes.
- 21 And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.

Moment in Mission to introduce our next Dollar Project, Sunday, June 4. Carole and Bill Schumacher will be with us to share about our new project beginning in June. They, along with a small group of former MCC co-workers, are trying to raise awareness about a very serious water safety issue (arsenic poisoning) in Bangladesh. It kills at least 43,000 people per year and disables many more. In response to this need Bill and Carole are working closely with SIM, a well-known and well-respected mission organization, to establish an arsenic project in a new area of Bangladesh, to expand their current work. Bill served with MCC as an agronomist in Bangladesh in the past. He and Carole are members at Sharon Mennonite Church in Plain City, OH.
