They, along with a small group of former MCC co-workers, are trying to raise awareness about a very serious water safety issue in Bangladesh that is almost unknown in the US. It kills at least 43,000 people per year and disables many more. In response to this need Bill and Carole are working closely with SIM, a well-known and well-respected mission organization, to establish an arsenic project in a new area of Bangladesh, to expand their current work. Bill served with MCC as an agronomist in Bangladesh in the past. He and Carole are members at Sharon Mennonite Church in Plain City, OH.
