Responsive Reading Philippians 2.1-11

Leader: ...If there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort in love, any sharing in the Spirit, any sympathy, complete my joy by thinking the same way, having the same love, being united, and agreeing with each other.

Piano Side: Don't do anything for selfish purposes, but with humility think of others as better than yourselves.
