A Statement about the immigration signs on our doors as you exit the building:

While we do not have any recent immigrants with us on Sunday morning, Open Arms does host people here and there is tutoring from time to time. When our doors are unlocked, ICE or other agents are free to enter and talk to people. When our doors are locked, ICE or other agents are not free to enter. They must have a judicial warrant, signed by judge, about a specific, named, person. Even when the door is cracked open to see who it is, they may enter. Those signs on the doors are there to remind anyone

in building of these rights should anyone come. Please check intent before opening a door for someone.
