

WINGS Update

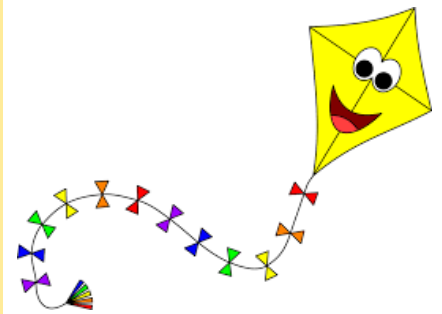
